**INVITATION**

- The Grapevine Sailing Club (GSC) cordially invites you to attend the Mayor's Cup Regatta on April 30<sup>th</sup> & May 1<sup>st</sup> 2016.

**SITE**

- GSC is a private sailing club, located on the south shore of Lake Grapevine at Scott's Landing Marina. Directions and other information relating to GSC appear at [www.grapevinesailing.org](http://www.grapevinesailing.org).

**RULES**

- The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the ISAF *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016*, applicable one-design class rules, and the Mayor's Cup Sailing Instructions (SI's).

**RACING**

- The event will consist of up to five (5) races. One (1) race shall constitute a regatta.

**ELIGIBILITY**

- Open to all sailors; GSC members and non-members alike.

**FLEETS AND HANDICAPS**

- Four (4) or more one design boats may constitute a fleet.
- Non one design boats will be grouped in PHRF fleets.

**COURSES**

- Races will be sailed on courses of Windward/Leeward design or variations thereof from GSC course illustrations attachment A.

## **ENTRY AND FEES**

- The entry fee for this regatta is \$75.00.
- Early online registrants that enter before 24:00 (midnight) CDT Saturday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015 will receive a \$15.00 discount.
- Members of US sailing will receive a \$5.00 discount at any time. Only one discount allowed per entry.
